Step 1: Create a new NY.GOV Account

- a) Enter First Name, Last Name, E-mail Address, Confirm E-Mail Address
- b) Select CAPTCHA checkbox
- c) Click Create Account

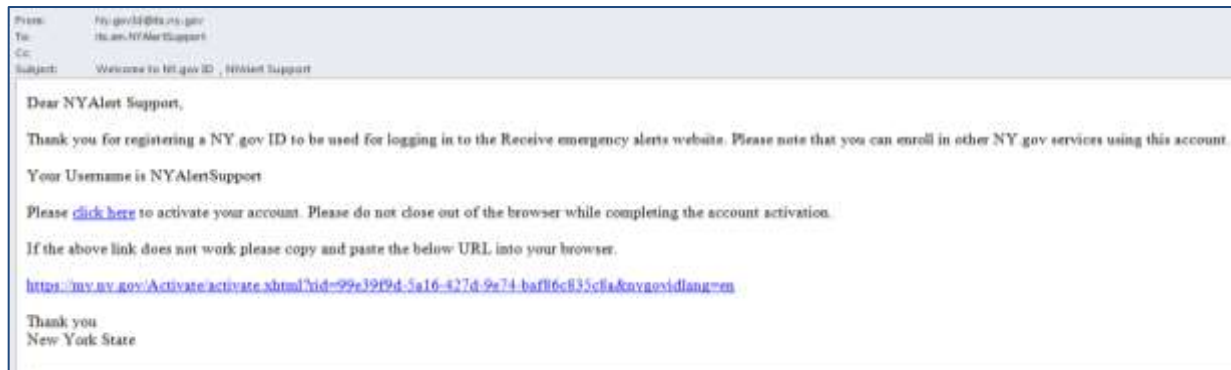

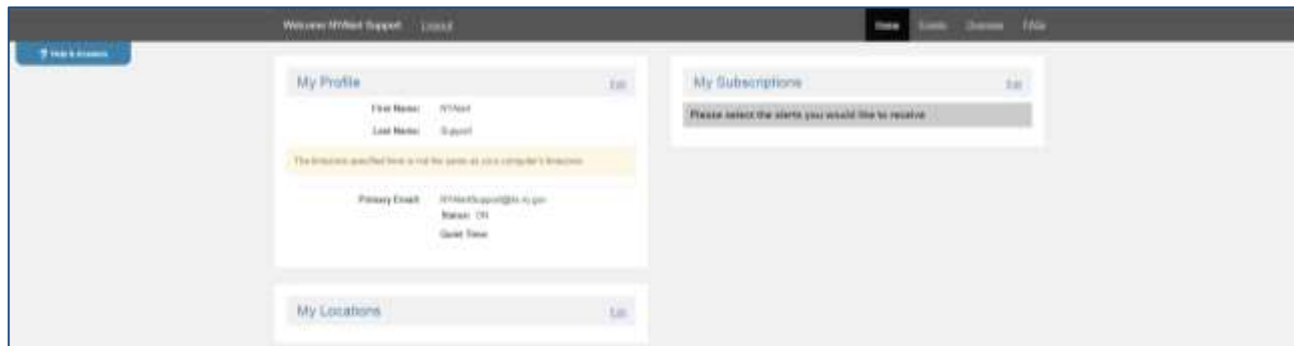

- Click Continue




Step 7: System Redirects to NY-Alert System



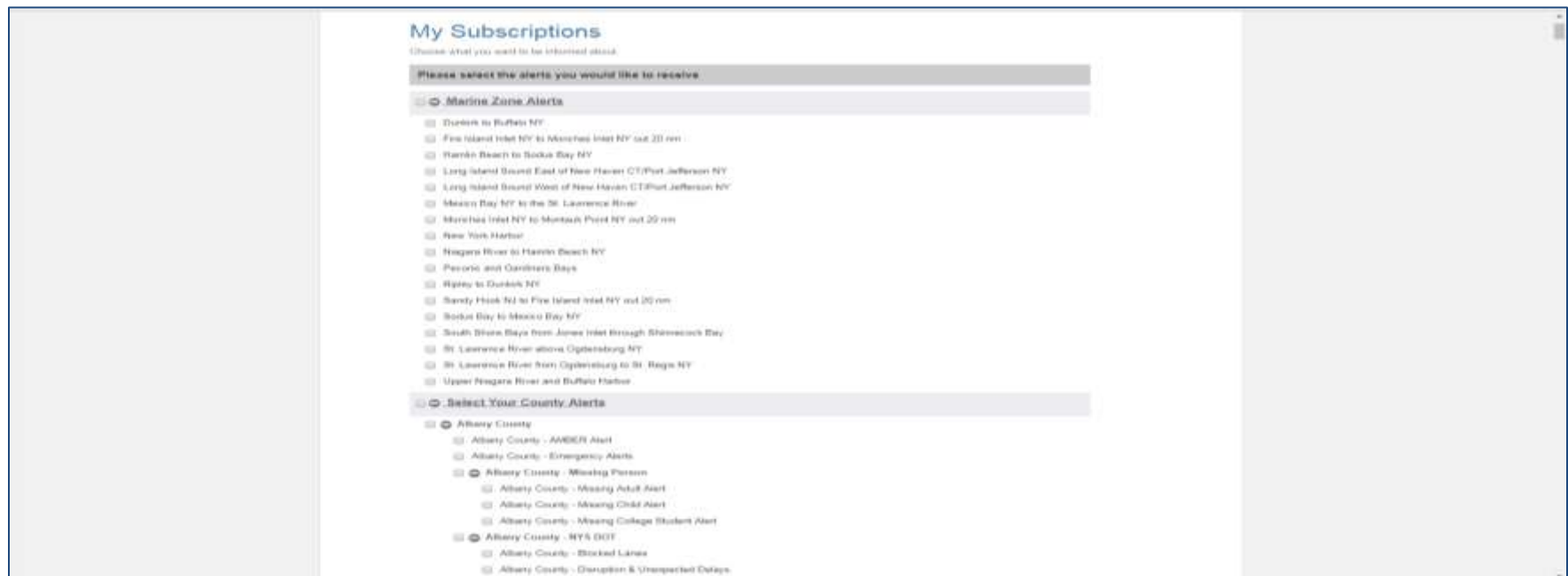
Step 9: Edit My Locations
